Jerusalem

Jerusalem is the capital of Israel and is by far the largest city in Israel. Located in the Judean Mountains, modern Jerusalem has grown far beyond the boundaries of the Old City. Jerusalem is the city of three religions and is sacred for Jewish, Christians and Muslims. Jerusalem is more than 3000 years old, has captivating history and architecture. At the same time the downtown is very modern.

- Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport, you will be welcomed by one of our representatives immediately after passport control. Our representative will help you with the luggage pick up, accompany you through the customs control, and will introduce you to your driver.

Optional (depending on the time of arrival):

Highlights of Tel Aviv: Rothschild, Old Yaffo Port, Flea Market. Lunch at the Old Man & The Sea restaurant: traditional lunch with 20 fresh salads for the starter + main dish to choose from (fish, seafood, or meat), mineral water, pitchers of lemonade, Arabic coffee.

16:00 - transfer to Jerusalem and check-in.

20:00 - dinner at the Eucalyptus restaurant with special makluba presentation by chef Moshe Basson. Dinner is family style and includes 1 glass of house wine and soft drinks, as well as lemonade in jars. Overnight: Jerusalem.
