In Kathmandu

Kathmandu, the capital city of Nepal, is a home to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites. The city is filled with rich culture, ancient traditions and hustling bazaars. It boasts natural beauty, vibrant culture, unique cuisine, and an intense religious devout that are apparent by the variety of festivals celebrated throughout the year.



Morning - Kathmandu Durbar Square

Located at the heart of the city, Kathmandu Durbar Square is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This old part of Kathmandu consists of small courtyards, shrines and to the royal palaces of the Malls kings. The main highlight is the temple of the living goddess, Kumari.



Afternoon - Swayambhunath Stupa

Rested on a hillock, Swayambhunath Stupa is one of the most important and sacred Buddhist shrines of Nepal. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is surrounded with smaller chaityas, temples, painted images of deities and numerous other religious objects.



Evening – Patan

Explore the city of architectural interior, a paradise of fine arts. Best known for its rich cultural heritage, it is filled with ancient palaces, pagoda temples, stone baths, Hindu and Buddhist statues, engravings and bronze cravings. Patan Durbar Square is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.











Morning - Pashupatinath

Visit the magnificent temple of Pashupatinath; an astonishing architectural beauty. Situated amidst a lush green natural setting on the bank of the sacred Bagmati River, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is Nepal's most renowned Hindu cremation site.



Afternoon - Bouddhanath Stupa

Stroll around this ancient UNESCO World Heritage Site; the center of Tibetan Buddhism. It is one of the most imposing landmarks of Kathmandu. The stupa's massive mandala makes it one of the largest spherical stupas in the world.



o Evening - Bhaktapur

The 'city of devotees', Bhaktapur takes visitors back in time. The extraordinary Bhaktapur Durbar Square is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and its monuments reflect the glory days of the Malla Dynasty when art and architecture thrived in the three cities of the valley.

Chitwan National Park – Jungle Activities

Rich in flora and fauna, Chitwan literally means 'heart of the jungle'. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Chitwan National Park is home to rare species like the Great Indian One Horned Rhinoceros, the Royal Bengal Tiger, gharials and several species of deer.

Get insights of jungle experience indulging in jungle activities like elephant ride, jeep safari, jungle walks, canoeing, etc. This is a great opportunity to get closed to the diverse ecosystem of the forests of Nepal.
