o Guna Yala

After breakfast, depart by charter flight to spend the day in Guna Yala. Situated in the Carribean Sea, the archipelago comprises more than 365 islands of which just 60 are inhabited. Savour a BBQ lunch of freshly caught lobster and giant crab, take a canoe ride through the azure blue waters passing white sandy beaches of the surrounding islands.
