The private visit of the villa will be exclusive by linking the venue and exhibition with live sculptures represented by the famous Czech Losers Cirque Company.

Secret of the hotel Jalta's underground

The bunker was built for senior Czech leaders and officers of the Warsaw Pact. Until 1989, it was the headquarters of the STB secret police, notorious for 'bugging' western guests of the hotel from ten metres (32 ft) below ground.
