
Then by Costa del Sol with its places full of history, the Arab-Andalusian culture, the music that carries us away, the beach rosaries. It is Andalusia!!















Afternoon – Discovering Madrid

The first afternoon of your trip starts with a highlights tour of the Spanish capital going from its more emblematic locations like the well-known Castellana Avenue, Cibeles square, Retiro park to the new quarter called Madrid Rio. The Tour will finish with an exclusive visit of the Royal Palace, a real jewel of Madrid which is the largest one in western Europe and still used by the Spanish Crown in Official Receptions, Presentation of Credentials and Official Events, such as State Meetings.

At the end of the tour, a drink will be served on a city center Rooftop to enjoy an outstanding view on the city.

Discover the heart of Madrid

Madrid of "the Austrian district" is the name given to Madrid at the time when the Habsburg dynasty reigned in Spain. This tour if going through the Renaissance and Baroque buildings of this period, the most picturesque in the city: Plaza Major, Puerta del Sol, Real Theatre, Opera house etc.

Morning- Discovering Ronda and its surroundings

Departure to Ronda, the famous white village located around 1h30 driving from Malaga.

"El Tajo" river separates the new city of Ronda which dates from the XVe century to the old towns which dates to the Arabic period.

After a nice walk on" Puente nuevo", the famous bridge made of stone offering fantastic views, let's discovering the bullring of the new city, a legendary plaza from the 18th century, one of the city's most outstanding monuments.



Lunch time

Oil tasting and appetizers in a fantastic farm of more than 25 hectares that promises to be a pioneering oleo tourism experience in our environment.

Owners elaborate organic extra virgin olive oil since the last 90s in Ronda.

Barbecue lunch outside followed by the possibility to visits organic orchards and vineyards decorated by famous' artists sculptures, centuries-old olive groves as well as a small Hermitage form the XIX century and recently restored.



Spanish evening

Last evening in a fantastic "Cortijo", beautiful Andalusian's style farm composed by towers and typical courtyards located 10mn from Marbella.

Typical dinner with horse shows, "venenciador" serving wines and Andalusian gastronomy in a relaxing and authentic Spanish way. Possibility to have a slight bullfighting demonstrations and how to manage a bull.


















Morning- Explore the city that makes everybody feel at home!

It is time to finalize your last shopping and bring back some souvenirs from Spain


