Relaxing evening at the beach with possibility to have dinner on the terrace with stunning views over the seaside.



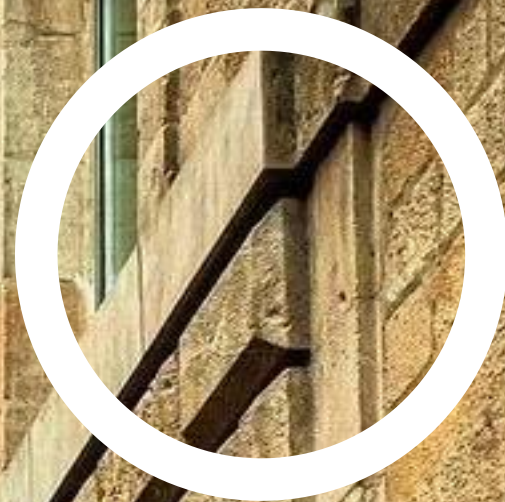

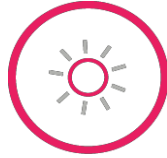

During the tour you will explore the Gothic neighborhood which dates to the Medieval times. Its small streets remained a labyrinthine and lead to magnificent squares. Most of the quarter is closed to regular traffic and offers you countless small bars, restaurants, shops, cultural as well as historical sights. You can also decide to visit museums such as the famous Picasso Museum. The renown painter moved to Barcelona in 1894 at the age of 14 and spent many years there.

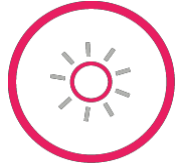

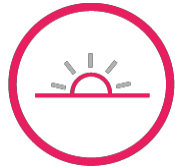


Time to pack for next destination

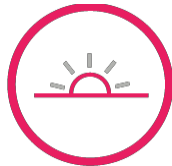
Discover the secrets of the traditional Majorcan cuisine
