Stockholm is the capital of Sweden, along with being the largest city in the country.

The city of Stockholm has about 1 000 000 inhabitants, while the region of Stockholm has more than 2 million inhabitants.

Since the 13th century, Stockholm has been serving as the political and economic center of Sweden. The city became the venue for the award of the first Nobel Prizes, in the year 1901.

The city's subway is also known as the world's longest art gallery, with the majority of its stations being adorned with paintings, sculptures and mosaics. Stockholm is also one of the most crowded museum-cities in the world, with around 100 museums, visited by millions of people every year.

Fem Små Hus Lunch

Right next to St George and the Dragon, in the heart of Stockholm's Gamla Stan, is **Fem Små Hus**.

A first-class restaurant serving guests a mix of Swedish cuisine with a French twist in a fantastic historic setting.

The restaurant's seven beautiful underground vaults span across five buildings, along Nygränd and down to Skeppsbron. A woman by the name of Anna Lindberg was running a restaurant here as early as the 17th century.

Guided City Tour Feel like a local

It is regulated by law that the guided tours in Sweden is accompanied by a certified guide. This extra person would join the groups on their respective tour to create something extra, e.g.: musician on the music tour, design student at the design tour etc. Below are the tours that we have chosen to offer your guests. Guided City Tour Metro tour

Starting at Hotel Haymarket by Scandic, this tour will take your guests on a journey through the Stockholm metro system. They will start their tour at Hötorget station, close to Hotel Haymarket by Scandic. Continuing their tour underground your guests will get the chance to visit what is said to be the world's longest art exhibition - 110 kilometres long. The guests will visit stations such as Kungsträdgården, which is designed with inspiration from the palaces, current and past, that have been located at Kungsträdgården. The tour end destination is Rådhuset metro station which is decorated with playful details from Kungsholmen's history. After the visit to Rådhuset station the guests will visit **W by Wijnjas** for a welcome drink.





Guided City Tour Welcome drink – W by Wijnjas

In a basement on Kungsholmen, Restaurant **W by Wijnjas**, a traditional restaurant houses plenty of cheese and food in a rustic and cozy environment. Good wine, good cheeses and good company have been at the centre of attention since Alf Wijnjas opened the restaurant with a wine cellar at Kungsholmen 40 years ago.







Guided City Tour Medieval tour

This tour will take your guests to the small island of Riddarholmen, just a short walk from the Old Town. Together with the Old Town the island forms the historical centre of Stockholm.

At Riddarholmen your guests will get the chance to visit a medieval church, Riddarholmskyrkan, built during the 1200s. The tour will end with a welcome drink at the famous medieval bar **Aifur**.





Guided City Tour Welcome drink – Aifur

Aifur is located in the middle of the Old Town. At Aifur they have done everything to make the decor, food, music and atmosphere reminiscent of how our old ancestors lived. At the venue your guests will find exact replicas of objects found in graves and excavations all over Europe. Lovely players often sit on the small stage and play all kinds of unusual and historically interesting instruments.





Guided City Tour Old Town

Gamla Stan, the **Old Town**, is one of the largest and bestpreserved medieval city centers in Europe, and one of the foremost attractions in Stockholm. This is where Stockholm was founded in 1252.

All of Gamla Stan and the adjacent island of Riddarholmen are like a living pedestrian-friendly museum full of sights, attractions, restaurants, cafés, bars, and places to shop. Gamla Stan is also popular with aficionados of handicrafts, curious, and souvenirs. The narrow winding cobblestone streets, with their buildings in so many different shades of gold, give Gamla Stan its unique character. Even now cellar vaults and frescoes from the Middle Ages can be found behind the visible facades, and on snowy winter days, the district feels like something from a storybook.





Guided City Tour Welcome Drink – Pharmarium

Pharmarium is the cocktail bar with sweeping drinks and bar snacks. Located in the middle of the Old Town at Stortorget, where Sweden's first pharmacy was once opened in 1575. With inspiration from the antique pharmacy, they create interesting flavours with questionable ingredients and a large dose of imagination.

Their excellent bartenders will create a special welcome drink for your guests.

Trattorian Dinner

Trattorian, located right by the water on Norr Mälarstand. At Trattorian your guests will have a rustic and authentic Italian dining experience with first-class ingredients in focus. Here the cooking rests on generations of culinary tradition and the dishes are matched with a well-sorted wine list.

Fotografiska Guided tour & Lunch

Fotografiska is the largest photography museum in the world. They celebrate photography, but beyond being a simple museum they offer inclusive spaces for conversation and community.

Unlike traditional museums, it is not Fotografiska's role to display its own collection. Instead, their exhibitions are developed directly with the artists, estates, collections and galleries or curated around a central theme. The lunch at Fotografiska is served with one of Stockholm's most beautiful views. The restaurant offers plant-based dishes, with vegetarian and vegan options highlighting the menu.







Sea Activity RIB boat – The Mission

The mission is a team competition in a high tempo where the team is faced by a number of challenges. Each task is worth different amount of points and they are of different characters which means that the team has to prioritize and make use of the team's different talents to gather as many points as possible.

The mission puts different demands on the team's abilities and can consist of for example brainteasers, to find places and code words, bonus competitions, photo assignments, to produce something etc. At one point in the competition the teams will get the chance to go on a RIB and experience the speed sensation.

Vasa Museum Guided tour, Aperitif & Dinner

The **Vasa** ship capsized and sank in Stockholm 1628. After 333 years on the seabed the mighty warship was salvaged, and the voyage could continue. Today Vasa is the world's best preserved 17th century ship and the most visited museum in Scandinavia.

Start the evening with an exciting tour around the ship Vasa and learn all about the amazing warship. The tour will end with an aperitif at the top floor, which will give your guests a spectacular view of the Vasa ship.

After the aperitif, your guests will sit down for dinner under Vasa's bow. An experience that will be hard to forget!

City Activity Rooftop tour

Welcome up on the roof!

Rooftop tour is an exciting guided tour over Stockholm, 43 meters above the ground. Here your guest get to experience some of Stockholm's best views, with both well-known and new sights to look out over. It is, as the name suggests, a walk along an exposed track. It includes no climbing; it is a guided, historical walk along a catwalk, on top of the old Parliament building on Riddarholmen.

On the roof, the guides tell anecdotes and the history of Stockholm as a city and Sweden as a country.

During the tour, the participants are secured to a security system while walking on the roof top.







City Activity Cinnamon bun baking

Together with a pastry chef your guests will learn how to bake "the Swedish fika" - cinnamon bun and chocolate ball. You get to brush, bake, roll and decorate your pastries. The guests then have the opportunity to stay in the café to have a cup of coffee and enjoy their baked goods.
