


Austin

Morning - Arrival and Meeting

Evening – Hill Country Sampler

You'll experience why 2,000 people a day flock here to indulge on famous brisket and out of this world sides.









Morning – Float Austin!

Enjoy the sights of Austin from the water during the Urban Kayak Tour. On the guided tour, you will paddle next to downtown, surrounded by the boardwalk and active hike and bike trail. Likely you will see plenty of wildlife including herons and turtles! The guides will give you history to the area and local landmarks along the way. Once you're insight of the Congress Ave Bridge, the guides will give you the facts to the largest urban bat-colony that call that bridge home.





Afternoon – Rollin' and Rockin'

See what makes Austin the "Live Music Capital of the World" via electric bike with an Austin musician as your guide! This private tour is a one of a kind music lover's tour of Austin, guided by a local musician. You'll see where the clubs are, hear behind-the-scenes band stories, and learn what makes Austin one of the richest centers for original music in the world. Part of the proceeds from each tour go to HAAM (Health Alliance for Austin Musicians), a local non-profit that provides access to affordable health care for Austin musicians. This very unique private tour includes an after-ride performance by your guide.



Evening

Start your evening off at Proof & Copper in their Whiskey Library for an intimate dinner of homemade Southern Fried Chicken, Mashed Potatoes, Braised Greens and Macaroni and Cheese. Then head out to the famous Deep Eddy Vodka Distillery for a tour and tasting. You'll enjoy a tasting flight followed by specialty cocktails made from their award winning vodkas. End your evening at Treaty Oak Distillery, one of the oldest distilleries in Texas where you'll have a tour and fun educational session and tastings of beers and spirits.
