


San Antonio

It is home for rare birds, terrestrial orchids, steep hills and deep canyons. It is internationally known for bird watching. Perched on the edge if the Balcones Escarpment, Friedrich is a nesting site for two federally listed endangered species of birds: the Black-capped Vireo and the Golden-cheeked Warbler.



Afternoon – A Slice of Local Culture

Enjoy lunch at the local notable Liberty Bar, a converted convent turned eclectic restaurant. Their motto is..."it's never too late to enter a convent, just don't make it a habit." Afterwards, we'll cruise from landmark to landmark taking in San Antonio's 300 years of history. 2018 is the city's Tricentennial, so join in on this celebration! A guided stroll of the King William neighborhood in which the guide will point out the families who settled into the area and are known as the Captains of Industry for San Antonio, a walking tour of Mission San Jose, the Queen of all the missions, a self guided tour of the Alamo and a quick trip up 952 steps to the Tower of America observation deck. Evening

As guests step off their bus they will be directed into the Tejas Rodeo grounds for a true Texas experience where guests will enjoy legendary BBQ while taking in some good ole country music filling the air through the amazing space. After dinner, guests will make their way to the 30,000 sq. ft. arena for a true Texas Rodeo experience. Guests will enjoy a private professional rodeo performance which includes opening ceremony complete with a horse drawn chuckwagon & longhorn cattle entrance, award winning drill team, presentation of the flags, adrenalin filled bull riding, team roping and barrel racing speed events.
