# St. Stephens's Cathedral

St. Stephen's Cathedral (German: Stephansdom) is the mother church of the Archdiocese of Vienna and the seat of the Archbishop of Vienna. Its current Romanesque and Gothic form seen today, was largely initiated by Rudolf IV and stands on the ruins of two earlier churches.

As the most important religious building in Austria's capital, the cathedral has born witness to many important events in the nation's history and has, with its multi-colored tile roof, become one of the city's most recognizable symbols.

The history of the palace and its vast gardens spans over 300 years, reflecting the changing tastes, interests, and aspirations of successive Habsburg monarchs.

Moreover, the tour includes Maria Theresa's most important state rooms on the bel étage: the Great and Small Galleries, the Carousel Room and Hall of Ceremonies. The Great and Small Galleries are counted among the most resplendent banqueting halls of European Rococo, with their gloss-painted white walls, their opulent gold decorations, and the ceiling frescoes by the Italian painter Gregorio Guglielmi.

What is more, the Carousel Room and the Hall of Ceremonies – likewise in the typical white-and-gold decoration typical of Maria Theresa's epoch – have large-format paintings integrated in the wall panelling which document Maria Theresa's reign in remarkably exact detail.

With 14 horsepower behind you, you can explore Vienna properly: the "Hot Rod Tour" will take you through the city on motorized soapboxes. After a short orientation (gas and brake pedals, reverse gear, handbrake and indicators) you will be set to go. A crash helmet for the journey will be provided.

The route goes around the Ring-Boulevard, past the major tourist sights and through the Prater with a view of the Giant Ferris Wheel and then over the Danube to the Vienna International Centre.

If you would prefer to be incognito in Vienna then this tour is admittedly not for you. At every red light, pedestrians and drivers alike will pull out their cell phones and take photos of the unusual vehicles.







# **Schloss Hof**

In 1725 Prince Eugene of Savoy purchased a seventeenth-century citadel with four wings and had it extended by two wings to surround the resulting Ehrenhof, the parade courtyard. Maria Theresa purchased the country seat thirty years later, in 1755.

The castle underwent radical changes between 1773 and 1775.

The building was raised one storey and the rooms on the first floor remodeled. – visit this beautiful palace and park and learn about its long and interesting history.

### Carnuntum

A visit to Carnuntum brings the ancient Roman period back to life. The region boasts architectural masterpieces, romantic ruins and precious treasures only roughly a half-hour drive away from Vienna.

The past begins here. Would you like to attempt to see how the Romans lived?

"Caesar's trophy" gives you the opportunity to do so. After reaching the Roman city quarter, Roman coins are minted. This is followed by an entertaining guided tour through the reconstructed Roman houses of the city quarter.

Afterwards, participants experience Roman life for themselves: in small groups the visitors attempt to put on a toga, try out chainmail armor and helmet, hunt boars and throw menhirs. But knowledge is also required and tested with a short quiz.

#### Carnuntum













"Wachau" is the name of the part of the Danube valley between Melk and Krems. These 35 kilometers cover the most beautiful region of Austria.

The Wachau is indeed one of the most romantic and almost magic river landscapes in the world.

The area is very famous for its excellent white wines – especially the Riesling. Dürnstein, situated on the northern banks of the Danube, is supposed to be the most beautiful and picturesque village. On a rock jutting into the river stands a chapel, which once belonged to an Augustinian monastery.

The baroque spire overlooking the Danube can be seen from far away.

#### Melk

Melk Abbey is one of the biggest and most beautiful European Baroque ensembles. Its splendid architecture is famous worldwide and part of UNESCO's world cultural heritage.

#### Dürnstein

Dürnstein is a small town on the Danube river district which is one of the most-visited tourist destinations in the Wachau region and also a well-known wine growing area. The town gained its name from the medieval castle Burgruine Dürnstein, which overlooked it.

#### Göttweig

Göttweig Abbey is a baroque Benedictine monastery and often referred to as Austria's Monte Cassino because of its fantastic location. Austria's Monte Cassino watches over the southern entry to the Wachau south of Krems like a acred fortress.

#### Krems

Krems an der Donau is the eastern gateway to the Wachau Valley. It is also one of the oldest cities in the land. This history extending back more than a thousand years is evident everywhere - in the streets and squares, in the old monasteries and churches, in the town houses and fortifications.

# Vienna meets Bratislava

Bratislava is the ancient coronation town of the historic Hungarian Kingdom, where between 1563 and 1830 eleven kings and eight royal wives were crowned.

The Royal Bratislava Walk, designed to place the city's history in its European context, follows the traditional route of the coronation procession, visiting Gothic St. Martin's Cathedral and other Habsburg heritage sites.

The highlight will be the neo-Classical Primatial's Palace, where in 1805 the Pressburg Peace treaty between France and Austria was signed. The Palace is famous for its collection of English tapestries.

## **Private Tour from Salzburg to Hallstatt**

Hallstatt, well-known by its breath-taking beauty, is considered as **one** of the most beautiful lake side villages in the world.

Your private tour takes you through the famous **UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Region Salzkammergut (Lake Area)** passing by many picturesque villages en route until you arrive at **Hallstatt** the **'Pearl of the Salzkammergut'**.

Hallstatt – it's hard to know where to start. Depending on season, explore the old town visiting the world-famous **Bone House** behind the Catholic Church or turn back time at the local museum – since a whole era of mankind was named after Hallstatt, the so called **Hallstatt Period** (800 BC – 400 BC).

Take a leisurely lakeside walk passing by the Mühlbach waterfalls and historic houses above you clinging onto the mountainside. Take the ferry or one of the **round trip boat cruises** to get even more breathtaking views from Hallstatt and the surrounding peaks.

For those who want to get real high – the **five fingers viewing platform**, probably of the most spectacular one in the world with a 400 meter drop. Enjoy awesome views of the **Dachstein Glacier** and its surrounding breathtaking mountain ranges while walking along the experience trail to the Pioneer Cross at 2.100 meters elevation.

Heading for the mountainous landscape of Salzkammergut, you will stop off at the idyllic Palace of Leopoldskron, the Benedictine monastery of Nonnberg Abbey, Lake Wolfgang, and the cloister church in Mondsee, where Maria walked down the aisle to meet the Baron at the altar.

As well as providing a glimpse into a timeless movie, the tour also takes in many other local pieces of history and culture along the way.

## Giant Ice Caves at Werfen

The "Eisriesenwelt" is a cave labyrinth with a total length of more than 40 kilometers. It was created over a very long time period. The first cracks and fissures in the limestone caves began to form during tectonic elevations about 100 million years ago. Chemical dissolution processes and water erosion across the millennia caused the subterranean cracks to increase, leading to the development of immense hollow spaces.

Alpine caves are in a development process even today, even if many cave systems - including large sections of the "Eisriesenwelt" are no longer changing significantly due to dehydration.






High up in the tower, you are treated to glorious scenery – out towards Salzburg City, the Untersberg and the Gaisberg.

## **Krimml Water Falls**

Don't miss out of one of the World's most striking natural spectacles and experience close up the incredible beauty and power of water. With more than 400.000 visitors a year this sight is rated among Austria's top 10 attractions.

Your private tour takes you into the heart of the Alps, passing picturesque alpine villages surrounded by magnificent alpine scenery.

After a 2 h ride, we arrive at the entrance of one of the most breathtaking destinations in the entire alpine region – the Krimml Water Falls. From there you enter the easy serpentine hiking trail with various platforms experiencing close up the natural wonder – water cascading down the valley over three stages with a total drop of 380 meters!

The lowest waterfall can be reached within 10 minutes by foot from the parking lot and is also disabled accessible, the highest point is at 1500 meters elevation with 431 meters attitude change.

Therefore the Krimml Water Falls are the perfect destination for all nature lovers – no matter if you are looking for adventure tackling the entire waterfalls or for pure relaxation – just feel rejuvenated in the mist breathing the incredible brisk fresh air.
